Every February, we rise - in hundreds of countries across the world - to show our local communities and the world what one billion looks like. We rise to express joy and community and celebrate the fact that we have not been defeated by this violence. We rise to show we are determined to create a new kind of consciousness - one where violence will be resisted until it is unthinkable.

Bakersfield is proud to be a participant in the VDay 2016 Community Campaign. We have been granted the rights for a V-Day benefit production of Eve Ensler's award-winning play, *The Vagina Monologues* as a way to raise money and awareness for local organizations that work to stop violence against women and girls. In addition to *The Vagina Monologues*, we will also be producing the VDay Women's Festival.

In 2015, over 5,800 VDay benefit events took place, produced by volunteer activists in 140 countries around the world, educating millions of people about the reality of violence against women and girls, both locally and globally. In 2016, VDay Bakersfield will be one of thousands of VDay participants channeling their creative energy into making a difference as part of the V-Day Community Campaign. This will be possible, in large part, through the assistance and generosity of sponsors.

Part of what makes this event so special is the opportunity it offers to businesses in local communities: to participate in this global movement, to celebrate and honor the women and girls in your life and community, to be part of a collective voice, a voice that says NO to violence against women and girls.

We will be donating all profits from our VDay events to local organizations including The Alliance Against Family Violence and Sexual Assault, and for the first time this year - Kern Coalition Against Human Trafficking (KCAHT). KCAHT is a grassroots coalition that was created to facilitate a comprehensive approach to combat human trafficking in Kern County through prevention, protection, prosecution and partnerships.

In the last 12 years, VDay Bakersfield has raised over \$38,000.000. We are hoping that this year, our thirteenth, we can be even more generous with organizations that serve the community of Bakersfield. We are excited to continue our partnership with The Art and Soul Center non-profit as our fiscal agent.

In exchange for your generosity, we will include your business name and logo on all communications that go out – press releases, flyers, brochures, programs, etc. Over 1,200 people will see your ad while attending VDay events.
